ASSEMBLY


Your market stall frame is designed to slot together by hand as shown in the images below. You do not require any specialist tools for assembly. Use the below diagram in conjunction with the parts list shown on the opposite page to identify and place the parts within the frame assembly.

COUNTER, ROOF & SKIRT



Tarpaulins

All tarpaulins are equipped with eylets and permanently attached ball loop bungees with hooks that are designed to wrap around the market stall frame and hook back over the plastic ball of the bungee in order to keep the tarpaulin taught.

Counter Boards

Counter boards lie over the counter bars of the Market Stall. Counter boards H1 and H3 have cutouts in the corners which allow the boards to lock into place inbetween the legs at each end of the Market Stall frame.

- **Do not** climb on framework or counter top (where present).
- Do not use a steel hammer to assemble framework, doing so may cause damage to surface finishes or bodily injury.
 Note: no specialist tools are required to assemble this product but if so required, use a rubber or wooden mallet only.
- **X Do not** assemble framework on a steep incline.
- **Do not** let rain or snow accumulate on the roof canopy.
- When new, the framework assembly may be stiff. This stiffness will ease with regular use.
- When new, the framework of this product may contain loose metal filings. Be
 careful when first assembling.
- When new, oil residue may be present around connection points. Be careful when first assembling.
- This product is designed to withstand inclement weather conditions but it is always recommended that additional ballast or grounding anchors be used wherever possible. Anchoring is your responsibility. Damages caused by poor weather conditions are not warranted.
- In extreme gusty conditions it is advised that framework is disassembled entirely.
- This framework is designed for temporary use only and is not a permanent structure.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure that this product and its components, including the framework, tarpaulin and counter boards (where present) are completely dry before placing in storage. Failure to do so may result in mildew and/or rust or other damage to surfaces and finishes.
- Dirt should be removed from tarpaulins and framework using a cloth, soap and warm water. Do not machine wash.
- Dirt can be removed from plywood counter boards using a stiff brush and a small amount of water.
- Do not use caustic products such as bleach to clean any part of this product. Doing so may cause damage to surface finishes.
