


1. Remove all the poles from the bag. There will be two upright bars (with feet attached), A top bar with two curved ends and a smaller support bar for the base of the frame.
2. Assemble the two elasticated upright bars.
3. Add on the top cross bar. Aligning the spring clip on the uprights with the hole on the inside of cross bar upright sections.
4. Add the support bar into the base of the uprights and the feet. As the banner is put on so the poles will be held in place.



5. Holding the banner upside down by the opening, align the bottom of the banner with the top of the frame.
6. Hook the opening of the banner over the cross bar. On the longer banners you may need two people for this.
7. Pull the banner down evenly on both sides.
8. At this stage you may need to align the seam up with the outer edge of the frame. Then stretch the banner passed the bottom support bar and align the three tabs of velcro to hold the banner down and tight.
